T2 - Sycamore: Prune the end weight of the front most limb by no more than 4m will be removed without cut diameters not exceeding 150mm. T3 - Sycamore: thin the sub stem growing toward the neighbours property in order to alleviate lean strain on the union. Approx 20% of the leaf bearing material will be removed. G1- Sycamores: carry out a full formative thin by removing 20% of the leaf bearing material with cuts not exceeding 150mm, tend to lightly reduce the lateral spread of the trees where branch union with included bark are present
